Two important summits take place in Europe at the end of 2009: the 7th ministerial conference of the World Trade Organization (WTO) in Geneva and the UN climate summit in Copenhagen (COP15).

With a week between them, **60 activists from the global South will travel across Europe** through Switzerland, France, Belgium, Germany and Denmark. They will draw attention to the **consequences of neoliberal globalisation and climate change on their lives and show how to fight against them**. Together with local activists, they will look for alternatives to free trade, for meaningful action against climate change and for ways to unite the North and South in their struggle for a better world.

On Monday, December 7th, they will be in Brussels for a whole day of actions and debates!
